Most references are to the **Modern History** collection: e.g. "B-9" means "Modern History B-9".

References to other subject-classes are given in bold (e.g. Economics N-6)

The **Modern History** collection is arranged largely by place, and then by period. There is little provision for specific topics, so subject indexing is difficult.
